### **School Group Policies**

- We do not issue tickets; your group will be seated as you arrive.
   Chaperones must arrive and enter the theater with their school group.
- Only school groups of ten (10) or more persons with a limit of one adult for every four students\* are eliqible to register.
- Each group may request a maximum of eight (8) performances per academic year.
- Children under the age of four will not be admitted to the theater unless the performance is intended for that age group.
- Please adhere to our grade level recommendations for each performance.

- Do not bring extra students or chaperones on the day of the event.
