SEEING YOURSELF IN THE STORY: TRICK PHOTOGRAPHY FOR HISTORIANS AND WRITERS

For Teachers of Grades 3—8

Two-session workshop

6 hours of instruction time

Instead of confiscating students' camera phones, teachers can teach them how to use them for learning! In this two-session workshop, participants learn how to guide eager shutterbugs through an easy-to-learn "trick photography" technique using free web or tablet-based technology. Students can place themselves in historical photographs to build empathy for past generations, or they can re-create events from their own lives to generate a visual reference for writing. Participants should bring their tablet or laptop and camera to this exciting workshop!

In this workshop, participants learn how to take their class on a trip to the past through "trick photography," a process where students use free web or tablet-based technology to sneak posed photographs of themselves into historical images. This easy-to-learn strategy engages the "selfie" generation in the research of primary sources, building their empathy for the historical figures and everyday people who lived before them. DIGITAL STORYTELLING: PHOTOGRAPHY AS A WRITING TOOL

3 hours of instruction time

When students go through the writing process like photographers, they engage in a collaborative, visual process that engages and supports a diverse group of learners. In this workshop, participants learn how to guide young authors as they use storyboards to organize their stories into a series of pictorial scenes, then direct their classmates in photo shoots to create digital picture albums they can reference as they write. Participants should bring their tablet or a laptop and camera for this exciting hands-on workshop!
